OLYMPIC CLOSING CEREMONY

- 90 second Paralympic preview to play out towards the end of the Ceremony
- Asset to be shared with IPC members to publish across social media



CONTENT OVERVIEW

- The IPC will live-stream 19 sports on Paralympic.org and the Paralympics LIVE app via the OBS (Olympic Broadcasting Services)'s Paralympic Video Player, where visitors can choose between up to 16 parallel live streams covering streamed sports.
- All live streams will be also available on the Paralympics YouTube channel
- For the three sports (wheelchair fencing, taekwondo, powerlifting) not streamed live, a daily highlights video will be made available for each competition day featuring the best moments.
- Selected live streams will be shown on the Paralympics Facebook account in selected territories.
- Live streams will be 16:9, HD, and carry English commentary provided by OBS.
- Where agreed with national broadcasters, geo-blocking will be applied.

Big launch moment
The campaign launches to the world at 07:00 JST. The campaign film, social media content symbol and #WeThe15 are shared across all channels by the movement's many supporters.

More than 80 landmarks around the world are lit purple.

24
AUGUST

Opening Ceremony
WeThe15 has a dedicated segment in the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games Opening Ceremony. IPC President Andrew Parsons will introduce the campaign film to a global audience of 250m people watching the event.

24 AUG –

Paralympics begin
Endorsements continue from celebrities, Paralympians, and influencers. The movement continues to grow online.

Digital platforms and sponsor brands add their bespoke campaigns to the movement.

SEPTEMBER

Closing Ceremony
A dedicated segment in the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games Closing Ceremony further cements the importance of the movement. A video message of support from leaders of the international organisations involved in the campaign is broadcast to 200m TV viewers.

OUTDOOR / PRESS – EXAMPLE TAKEOVER



The purple strip should be positioned in a way that feels disruptive and eye-catching. If it looks too neat, it becomes self-defeating.

While it is important that the brand is obvious, the strip should interfere with the creative in order to make it impossible to ignore.
